## **EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE**

The London Reps sit on Executive Committee which meets every two weeks and is made up of Campus Reps from each main site and the three Sabbatical Officers.

The Executive Committee are the democratic leadership of the Students' Union. They make decisions on students' Ideas, plan campaigns, and delegate decision-making to Student Council, Liberation Networks, and Referendums.
