The Welfare Officer works to improve the health, welfare, and wellbeing of our members. They lead campaigns and lobby the University on all aspects of your physical, mental, and sexual health as well as your accommodation and finances.

ENGAGING WITH MEMBERS

The Welfare Officer is in daily contact with members, in person or online.

Though based on one site, they are supported to maintain a presence across all five main campus locations and attend member-led events.

The Welfare Officer works to constantly gather the views of members about their health, welfare, and wellbeing.

The Welfare Officer provides a weekly update to members on their work.

SUPPORT & PAY

The Welfare Officer is paid £17,408.92 per annum to fulfill their role.

They receive a period of induction during the summer as well as one-to-one coaching and mentoring from members of Students' Union and University staff throughout their term in office.

The Students' Union is committed to the personal development of all Officers and Representatives, including (but not limited to) additional training and support where necessary.

ADDITIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES

All Officers take on additional responsibilities within their role. The Welfare Officer:

- Acts as Student Director on the University of Cumbria Board of Directors
