Bye-Law 5: Campus Reps

1. Campus Representatives Roles

- 1.1. The Campus Representatives roles of the Students' Union are:
 - i) Ambleside Representative
 - ii) Ambleside Representative
 - iii) Brampton Road Representative
 - iv) Brampton Road Representative
 - v) Fusehill Street Representative
 - vi) Fusehill Street Representative
 - vii) Lancaster Representative
 - viii) Lancaster Representative
 - ix) London Representative
 - x) London Representative

2. Appointment

- 2.1. The Campus Representative roles under clause 1.1 are elected in accordance with the Constitution and Bye-Law 6: Elections.
- 2.2. The Campus Representatives shall commence their role on the 1st July following their election through 31st June the following year.

3. Status

- 3.1. The Campus Representatives are unpaid volunteers of University of Cumbria Students' Union.
- 3.2. The Campus Representatives are subject to the policies and procedures of the Union as outlined in the Constitution and Bye-Laws.

4. General Duties

- 4.1. All Campus Representatives are expected to undertake the following general duties:
 - i) To uphold the purpose, vision and values of the Union.
 - ii) To uphold the Constitution, Bye-Laws, and any other regulations or policies to ensure the effective governance of the Union.
 - iii) To represent students based on their campus to the Students' Union, University, and externally.
 - iv) To deliver actions and make democratic decisions on-behalf of students on their campus.
 - v) To support the provision of democratic systems that provide channels for student voice to shape the work of the Union, including elections and general meetings.

- vi) To be accountable to the membership, via the democratic systems, for delivery of actions and policy devolved to them.
- 4.2. All Campus Representatives are expected to attend the following meetings within the Students' Union and University:
 - i) Executive Committee,
 - ii) Any other formal meetings as required by the Students' Union.
 - iii) Any other formal meetings as required to ensure the fair representation and involvement of members in the University's decision-making.
- 4.3. All Campus Representatives are expected to engage with members to understand their issues, concerns, desires, and ideas across the breadth of the student experience by:
 - i) Maintaining a physical presence in the student community on their campus.
 - ii) Support student-led activities and events.
 - iii) Relaying and redirecting members' views, concerns, issues and ideas as appropriate within the operational and democratic structures of the Union to ensure effective and appropriate consideration and resolution.
- 4.4. All Campus Representatives are expected to support:
 - i) Student Groups on their campus,
 - ii) Any other student volunteers or student-led volunteering project on their campus.
